Yes! Families are encouraged to come. Children will be welcomed and valued as part of this prayer movement. We are believing for revival among every generation.

Can I Bring Pets?

Yes! This is an **outdoor park**, so **leashed pets are welcome** outside the Goat Barn area. **Please do not bring pets into the covered space** where the prayer and worship gatherings are held. Thank you for respecting the atmosphere of reverence.
